

# Delaware County Townships “Political Signs” regulations

*Compiled by the Delaware County Regional Planning Commission*

*February 4, 2014*

## **Brown**

Not more than **ninety (90) days prior** to the election and are removed within **fifteen (15) days after** the election by both winning and losing candidates.

## **Concord**

Not more than **forty-five (45) days prior** to any election, and all signs are removed within **fifteen (15) days following** any election.

## **Genoa**

Not to exceed **thirty (30) days before or three (3) days after** an election.

## **Harlem**

Not more than **thirty (30) days prior** to any election and all signs are removed within **ten (10) days following** any election.

## **Kingston**

Not more **than ninety (90) days prior** to the election and are removed **within fifteen (15) days following primary** elections by the losing candidates and within **fifteen (15) days following the general election** by both winning and losing candidates.

## **Liberty**

Not more than **sixty (60) days prior** to an election and are removed within **seven (7) days following** said election.

## **Marlboro/Thompson/Radnor (County)**

Not more than **ninety (90) days prior** to the election and are removed within **fifteen (15) days following primary** elections by the losing candidates and within **fifteen (15) days following the general election** by both winning and losing candidates.

## **Orange**

Removed within **fifteen (15) days following elections**, except by winning candidates following primary elections.

## **Oxford**

Not more than **ninety (90) days prior** to the election and are removed within **fifteen (15) days following primary** elections by the losing candidates and **within fifteen (15) days following the general election** by both winning and losing candidates.

## **Porter**

Not more than **90 days prior** to the election and are removed within **15 days following primary** elections by the losing candidates and within **15 days following the general election** by both winning and losing candidates.

## Berkshire

**Political Signs:** The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) may be posted and removed without destruction of public or private property.
- 3.) designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 4.) shall be placed outside the road right of way.

## Berlin

**Political Signs:** The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the Township provided that the property owner consents and said signs:

- 1.) Do not interfere with the clear sight triangle of vehicular traffic entering or leaving a public street.
- 2.) Are posted and removed without destruction of public or private property.
- 3.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 4.) The sign and all associated materials shall be placed outside the road ROW.

## Brown

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **are erected or posted not more than ninety (90) days prior to the election and are removed within fifteen (15) days after the election by both winning and losing candidates.**
- 3.) are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.

## Concord

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) do not interfere with visibility of Vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **are erected or posted not more than forty-five (45) days prior to any election, and all signs are removed within fifteen (15) days following any election.**
- 3.) may be posted and removed without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 5.) shall be placed outside the road right-of-way.

## Delaware

**Political Signs:** The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs: do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the road; may be posted and removed without destruction of public or private property; designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign; shall be placed outside the road right of way.

## Genoa

**D. Political Campaign Headquarter Signs** – Each principal Structure shall be limited to one Sign. The size of the Sign shall be limited in area to one (1) square foot per four (4) lineal feet of Building Frontage up to a maximum of twenty-five (25) square feet.

**E. Political Signs or Posters** – Such Signs involving any candidate for public elective office or any issues and similar matters to be decided by public election **may be erected for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days before or three (3) days after an election.** Political signs shall be permitted as Freestanding Signs in all Districts, and shall not be Attached to any Structures including telephone poles, light poles and Fences or located in any manner destructive to public property. The maximum Sign Area shall be six (6) square feet per side within any residential District and twenty (20) square feet per side upon private property in any other District. Political signs shall not be located in or closer than ten (10) feet to the edge of the contiguous public street Right-of-Way.

## Harlem

**Political Signs Or Posters:** Such signs involving any candidate for public elective office or any issues and similar matters to be decided by public election shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs meet the following criteria:

- 1.) Do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) Are erected or posted not more than thirty (30) days prior to any election and all signs are removed within ten (10) days following any election.**
- 3.) Are capable of being posted and removed without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 5.) No such sign shall exceed six (6) square feet per side with not more than two (2) sides

## Kingston

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district covered by this resolution provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) Are erected or posted not more than ninety (90) days prior to the election and are removed within fifteen (15) days following primary elections by the losing candidates and within fifteen (15) days following the general election by both winning and losing candidates.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 5.) Signs shall not be placed on public utility poles or public property.

## Liberty

**Political Signs:** The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the Township provided the said signs are located outside the right-of-way and that said signs:

- 1.) Shall not interfere with visibility of traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) Are erected or posted not more than sixty (60) days prior to an election and are removed within seven (7) days following said election.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Are not attached to any structures including utility poles, light poles and fences.
- 5.) Designate the name and address of the landowner and/or political candidate and committee charged with removal of the sign.
- 6.) Shall not exceed six (6) square feet in area per side.

## Marlboro/Thompson/Radnor (County)

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district covered by

this resolution provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **Are erected or posted not more than ninety (90) days prior to the election and are removed within fifteen (15) days following primary elections by the losing candidates and within fifteen (15) days following the general election by both winning and losing candidates.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 5.) Signs shall not be placed on public utility poles or public property

## Orange

**Political Signs** – the erection of political signs should be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **Are removed within fifteen (15) days following elections, except by winning candidates following primary elections.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.

## Oxford

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district covered by this resolution provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **Are erected or posted not more than ninety (90) days prior to the election and are removed within fifteen (15) days following primary elections by the losing candidates and within fifteen (15) days following the general election by both winning and losing candidates.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 5.) Signs shall not be placed on public utility poles or public property

## Porter

**Political Signs:** The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) **Are erected or posted not more than 90 days prior to the election and are removed within 15 days following primary elections by the losing candidates and within 15 days following the general election by both winning and losing candidates.**
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.

## Scioto

**Political Signs** – The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district under the Township Zoning Resolution provided that said signs:

- 1.) Are located outside the right-of-way limits of the road and do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway. Signs shall not be placed on Public Utility Poles or Public Property without proper authorization and in no event shall such signs be within public road right-of-way.
- 2.) Reserved for future narrative.
- 3.) Are capable of posting and removal without destruction of public or private property.
- 4.) Designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.

## **Troy**

**Political Signs** - The erection of political signs shall be permitted in any district of the township provided that said signs:

- 1.) do not interfere with visibility of vehicular traffic entering or leaving the highway.
- 2.) may be posted and removed without destruction of public or private property.
- 3.) designate the name and address of the person charged with removal of the sign.
- 4.) shall be placed outside the road right-of-way.
