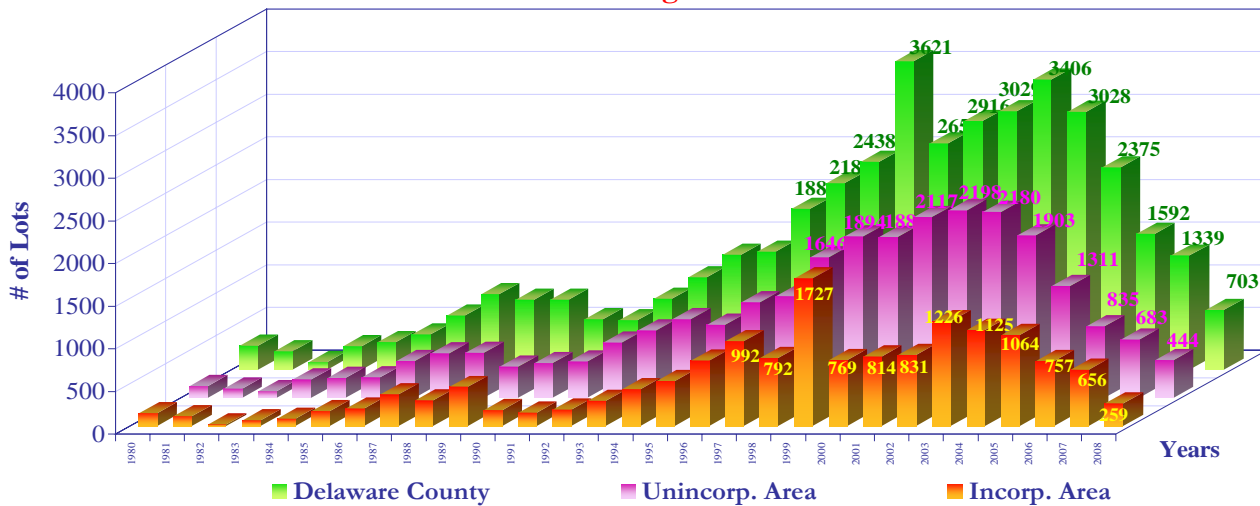


Residential Building Permit Trend in Delaware
